🕒 QCamel (Approx. 9:30am - 11:00am)
Get up close with Australia's gentle camels at QCamel, learn about the unexpected history of camels and First Nations communities, and enjoy morning tea featuring camel produce with stunning views of the Glasshouse Mountains.

🕒 TribalLink (Approx. 12:00pm - 2:00pm)
Walk with us, share with us, and immerse yourself in an authentic cultural experience. Meet the Traditional Custodians, paint with ochre, and learn about ancient tools and stories passed down through generations. Stroll through the rainforest to discover native bush foods, then enjoy a delicious Bush Tucker tasting lunch at the waterhole featuring seasonal and local flavours.





🕒 My Dilly Bag (Approx. 2:30pm – 4:00pm)
 Meet Bushfood Queen Aunty Dale Chapman and her bushfood besties from My Dilly Bag, a First Nations bushfood company dedicated to sharing the wisdom and flavours of First Nations cuisine. Learn about sustainability and traditional approaches to growing and sourcing Australian native foods.
